Agenda notes:

AOMM training rides:

Discussion: How many resources do we want to commit? – People, time, money, preparation. Results: start training rides in middle February. Paul T. to head up. He is making some minor route adjustments to his plan already set forth - add some more climbing. We will stick to leaving from the Spartanburg area, post routes before hand, and encourage to ride in ability groups. Courses will not be marked. No food during / after. Some rides will start from the 2 bike shops. We will contact all starting locations. Training rides posted on web (both Freewheelers and eRide). Rides will not be as logistically complex as in the past.

Budget:

All agreed on the budget. Need to adjust the webmaster's pay.

Jerseys for the club:

We'll wait to see how the AOMM sponsors play out. The top tier sponsors for AOMM will see an additional option of appearing on club jerseys. Potential sponsors are Global Bike, Sptbg CVB, connecting more to our race team. Discussion also included a possible jersey combo with the Biketown initiative sponsors.

Logos:

Walter from Great Escape:

He will show a presentation at the next meeting on his idea of documenting this year's event through the use of gopro digital cameras on various bikes. –Karl will coordinate.

LCI accreditation:

Paul L. spoke more on this topic. Although it would be a good idea to have these type instructors in the club as a selling point to bring in people new to cycling, PAL is a better fit for marketing this. Kelly K. did express interest perusing this education.

By-Laws:

Need to change what the club defines as a quorum. We will tie this question to the Mitchell registration process so we can get back the correct number required in Article VII section 2. –Karl to send to Angela.

Price House presentation by John:

The County Historical Assoc is applying for a grant and we agreed to help basically by saying we will continue to ride by on our rides and use it as a sag stop when we can. Karl and Paul T. signed the document.

Extra items discussed:

Pass-codes: the unwritten policy of 2 pass-codes for family memberships needs to be written down / changed after this year's event.
